## European method of cancer care helps patient in the fight of her life

Cancer patients sometimes stop chemotherapy, or never go back for a second round, because it makes them so sick.

Now there's a method, used largely in Europe that appears to reduce the side effects of chemo.

Diane had four tumors: three in her liver and one in her pancreas.

Currently, the tumors in Diane's liver are gone and the one in her pancreas is the size of a kidney bean.

She credits chronotherapy, a continuous dose of chemotherapy over a long period of time that peaks when cancer cells are most active and healthy cells are at rest.

Integrative Cancer Care Specialist, Keith Block, M.D., states, "That means you can give patients at higher doses and for longer periods, which means you're going to get a better effect at killing the cancer cells."

Other researchers say chronotherapy needs further study.

Diane says she has all the proof she needs.
